## **Course Appendix 2 – Yellow Course (Version 4.2)**

#### **NOTES:**

- Clause numbers refer to Standard Sailing Instructions.
- The Committee Boat will display a Pink Flag before the first scheduled Warning Signal.

#### **1. Rules**

1.4 Competitors in the Laser Class meeting shall comply with their Class Association rules.

1.5 An entry consists of the Helm and Boat combination, thus a change of helm constitutes a new entry. Note: Changes of crew are permitted at the discretion of the Race Committee. Such requests must be made in writing.

#### **4. Signals Made Ashore**

4.5 Fall D with one sound signal means “The warning signal will be made not less than 45 minutes after flag D is displayed”. Boats are requested not to launch till this signal is made.

#### **5. Schedule of Races**

5.1 Dates, number of races and times of the first warning signal of the day.

## 5.2 Briefings

There will be a briefing for competitors on the harbour side adjacent to the Club Flag poles at the inshore end of Haldon pier at 12:30 on Saturday August 19<sup>th</sup>.

## 6. Class Flags

6.1 The class flags for each class will be as follows:-

PY Dinghy	Numeral Pennant 6	
Fast Junior	Numeral Pennant 7	
Slow Junior	Numeral Pennant 8	

## 8. The Courses

8.1 The course configuration in the course diagrams show the course that will be selected. The courses and number of laps to be sailed by each class will be displayed on a board on the committee boat.

## 9. Marks

9.1 Marks will be as described on the course diagrams.

9.2 The change of course mark will be an orange inflatable buoy.

## 13 The Finish

13.4 The Finish line will be between the mast on the Committee Boat displaying an orange flag and a buoy displaying a Blue Flag

13.5 Where a Shortened course is signalled at a Leeward Mark, boats shall leave that mark to Port and proceed to the Finish line. This changes Rule 32.2

#### **14. Time Limits**

- 14.1 There are no time limits. The target time for the first boat in each class will be approximately 45 minutes. Failure to meet the target time will not be grounds for redress. This changes Rule 62.1(a)
- 14.2 Boats failing to finish the race within 15 minutes after the first boat in her class sails the course and finishes will be scored DNF without a hearing. This changes Rule 35, A4 and A5.

#### **15. Penalties and Exoneration**

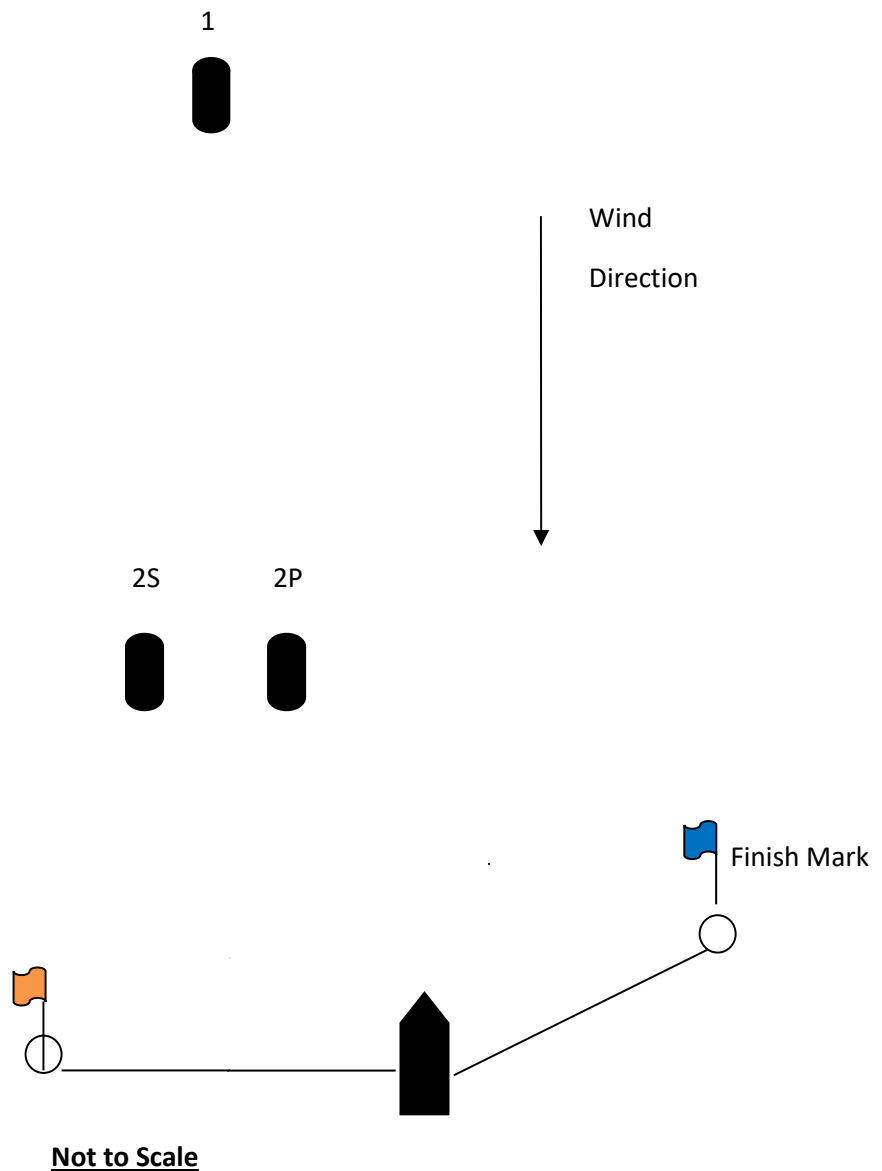
- 15.3 Boats may touch a mark other than the start and finish mark. A boat shall not manhandle a mark when it results in an advantage. This changes Rule 31.
- 15.2 RRS 44.1 and 44.2 is changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

#### **19. Safety**

- 19.2 A Tally system will operate for all Dinghies launching from the slipway in Torquay Harbour:
  - 19.2.1 The tally board will be located at the top of the slipway in Torquay Harbour.
  - 19.2.2 Competitors shall collect a tally before going afloat.
  - 19.2.3 Competitors shall return their tally to the tally board on returning ashore.
  - 19.2.4 Timing for the release of tallies prior to going afloat will be on the instruction of the course race officer and will be signalled by Flag D (see SI 4.5)
  - 19.2.5 All tallies shall be returned within 10 minutes of the last boat coming ashore
  - 19.2.6 Competitors who forget to tally out or tally in within the time limit will be liable to a penalty of £5.00 which will be donated to the RNLI payable at the race office.
- 19.3 Competitors in all Dinghy classes shall wear a personal flotation device at all times whilst afloat. This changes the preamble to Part 4 of rules and rules 40 and 27.1

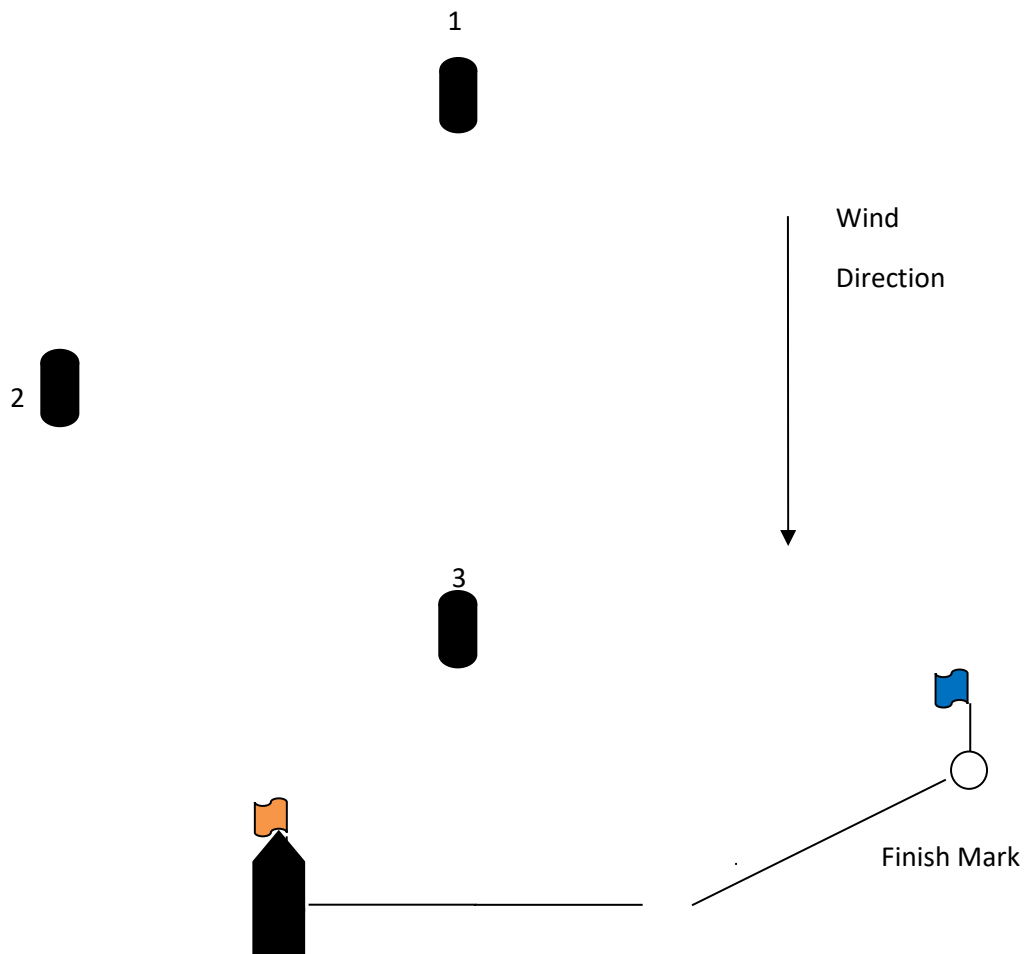


## Course Configuration 'B' – Windward / Leeward



1. Windward/Leeward courses will be described as WL on the course board
2. All laps comprise mark 1 and 2s/2p except final lap or shortened course when last leg is from 2p to finish.
3. If only one leeward mark is laid, this is to be rounded to Port
4. Marks 1,2s and 2p will be Black inflatable buoys.
5. If Shortened course is at a Leeward Mark, boats shall leave that mark to Port and proceed to the Finish line
6. Finish between committee boat and finish mark
- 7 The change of course mark will be a Orange inflatable buoy.

**Course Configuration 'C' – Triangle / Sausage**



**Not to Scale**

1. Triangle/Sausage courses will be described as TS on the course board
2. All laps are as described in the table below except final lap or shortened course when last leg is from 3 to finish.

<b>Course TS</b>	
Lap	Mark rounding order
1 <sup>st</sup> and subsequent odd number laps	Start-1-2-3
2 <sup>nd</sup> and subsequent even number laps	Start-1-3

3. Marks 1,2 and 3 will be Black inflatable buoys.
4. If Shortened course is at a Leeward Mark, boats shall leave that mark to Port and proceed to the Finish line
5. Finish between committee boat and finish mark
6. The change of course mark will be an Orange inflatable buoy.
