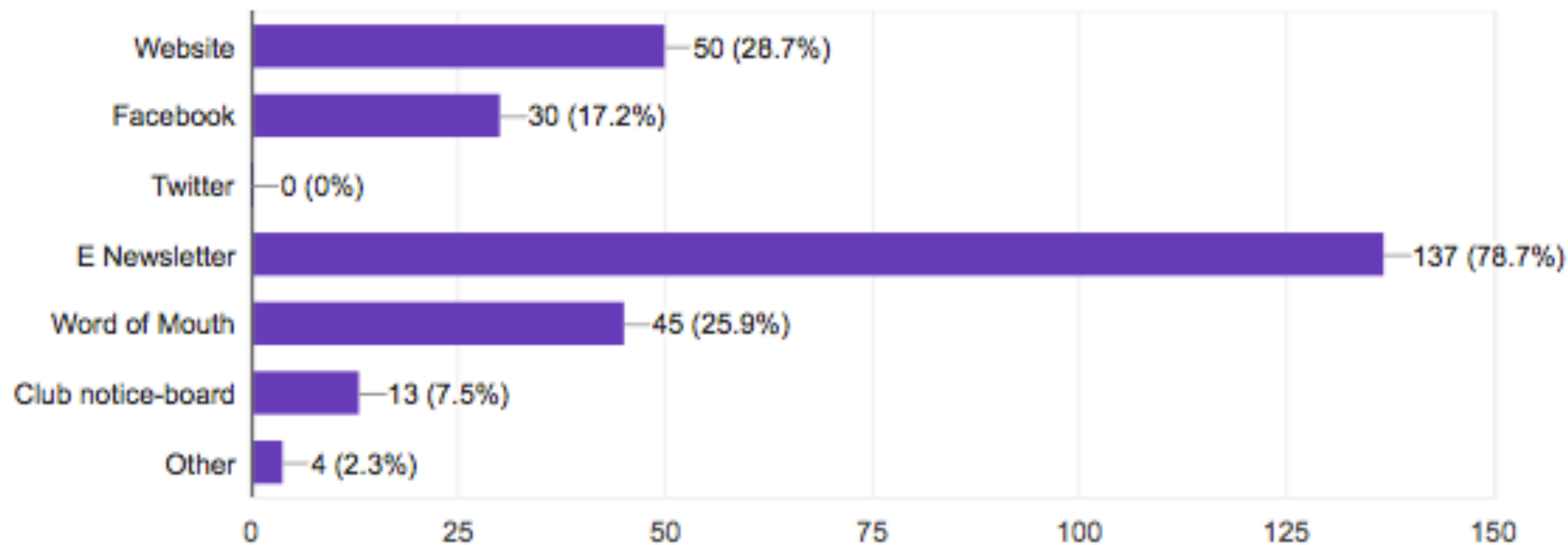

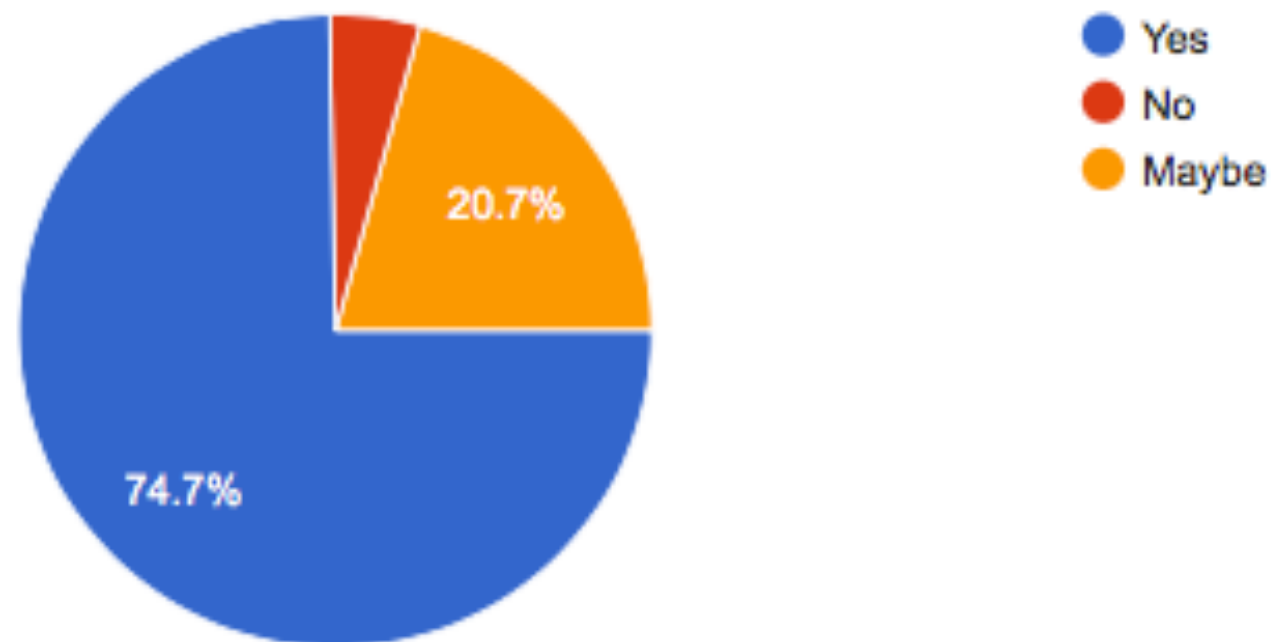
How do you mainly find out what is happening at the club?

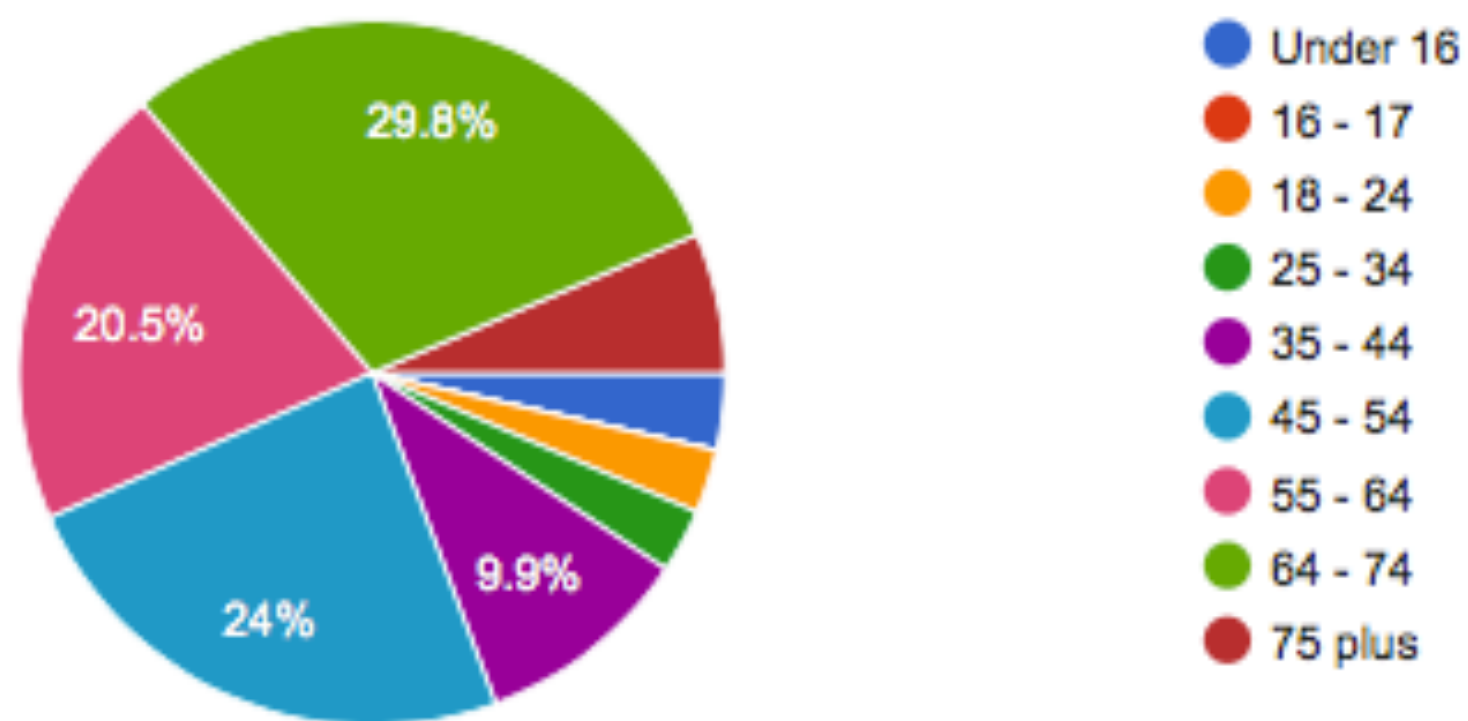

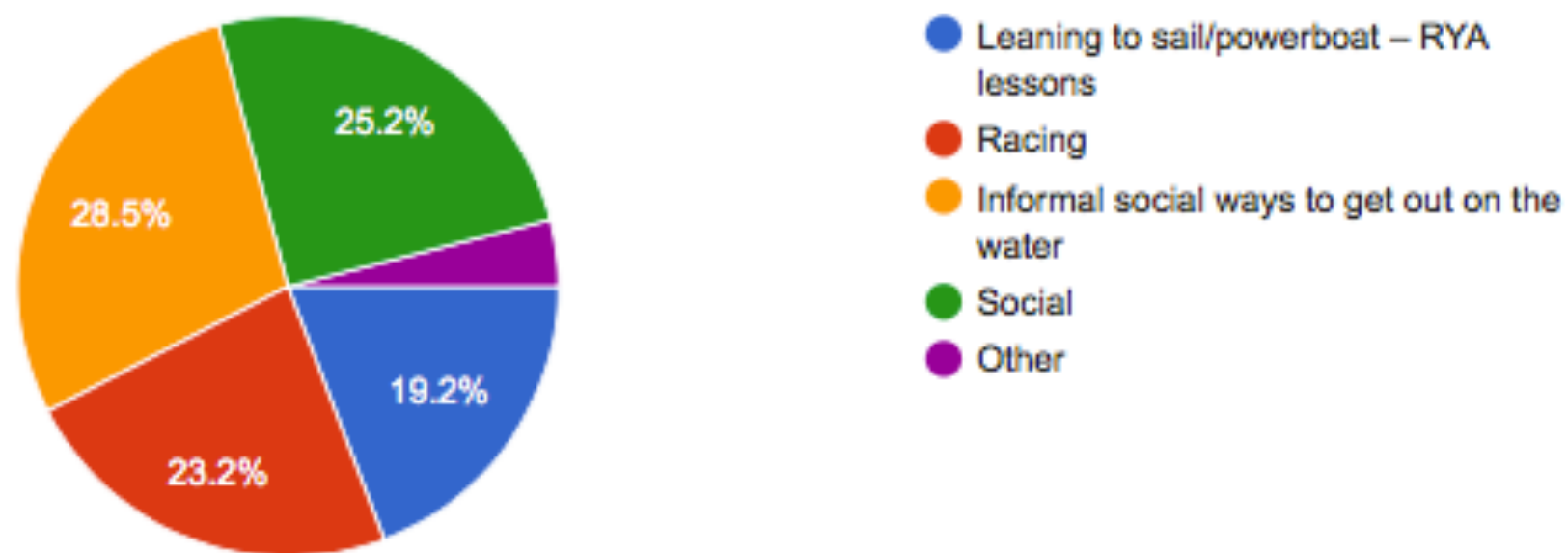

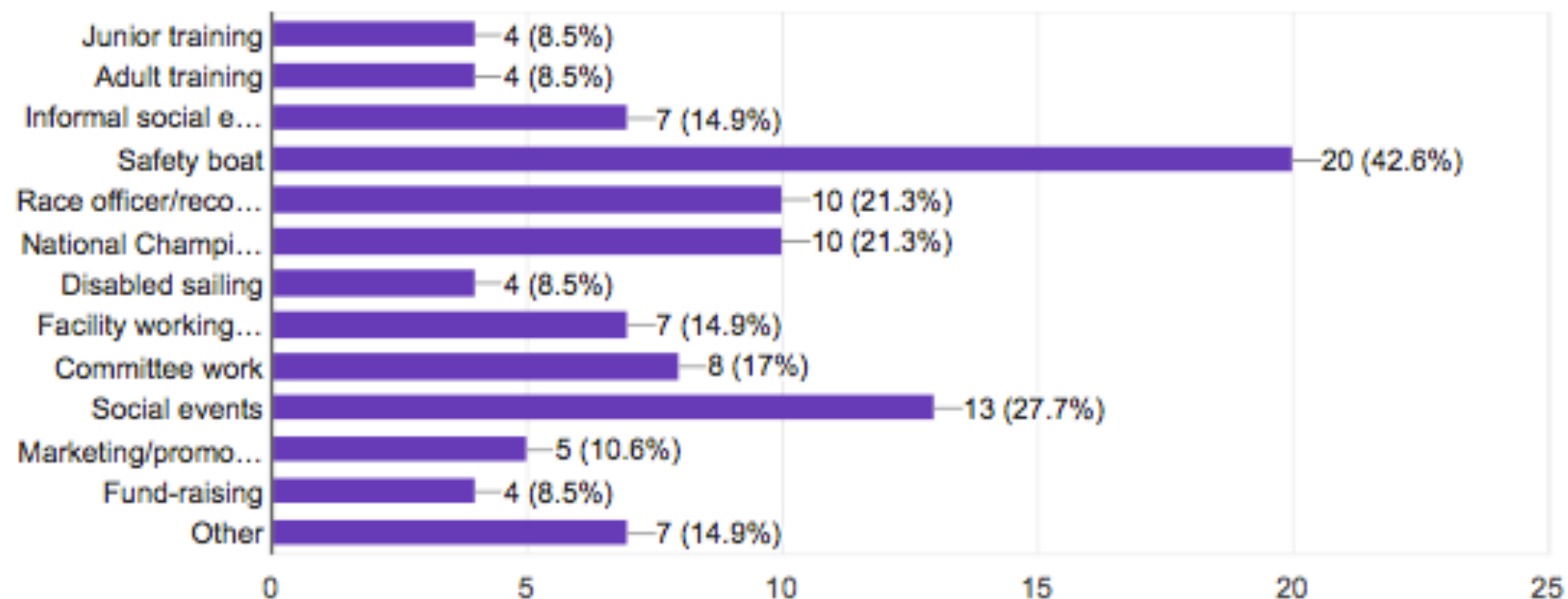

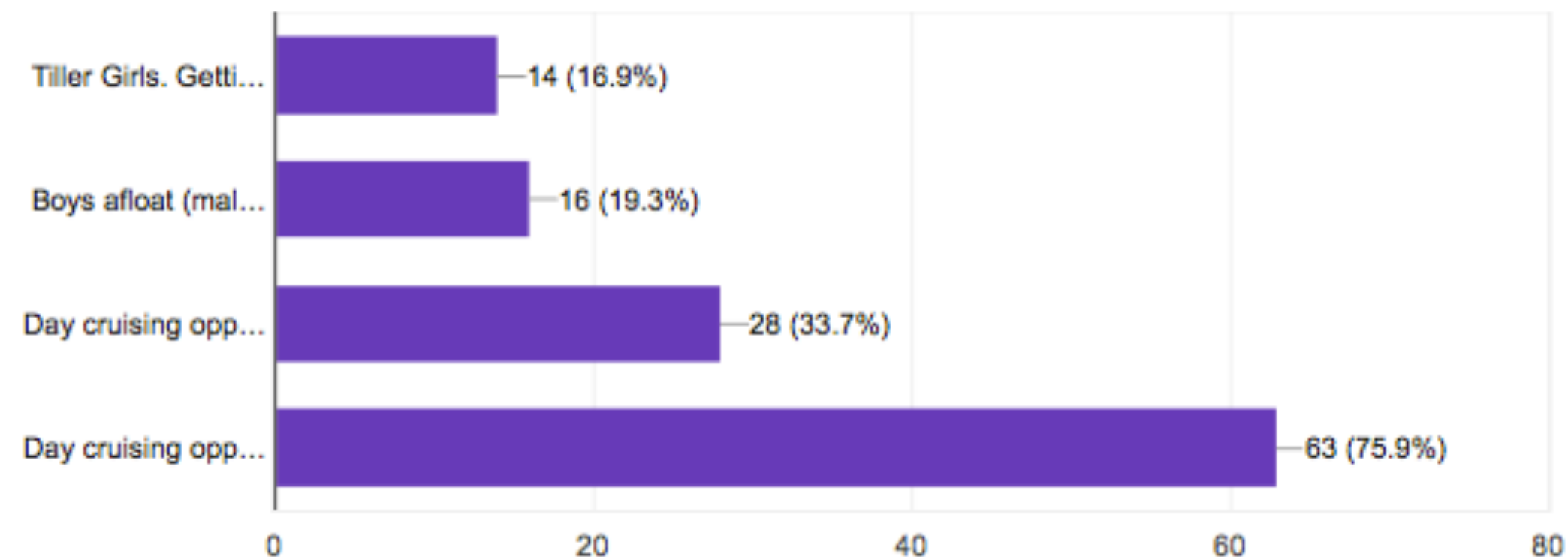

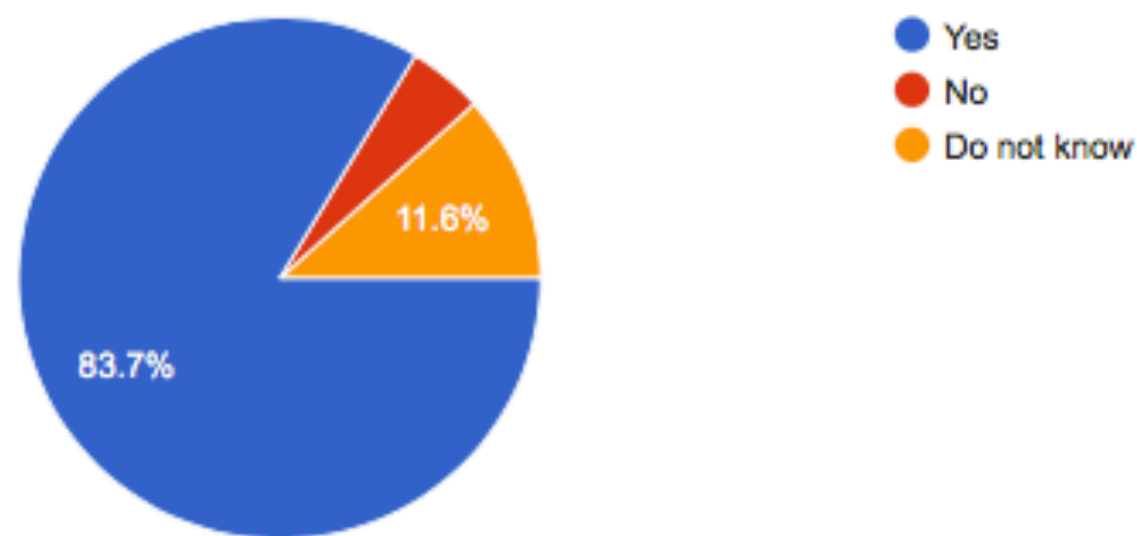

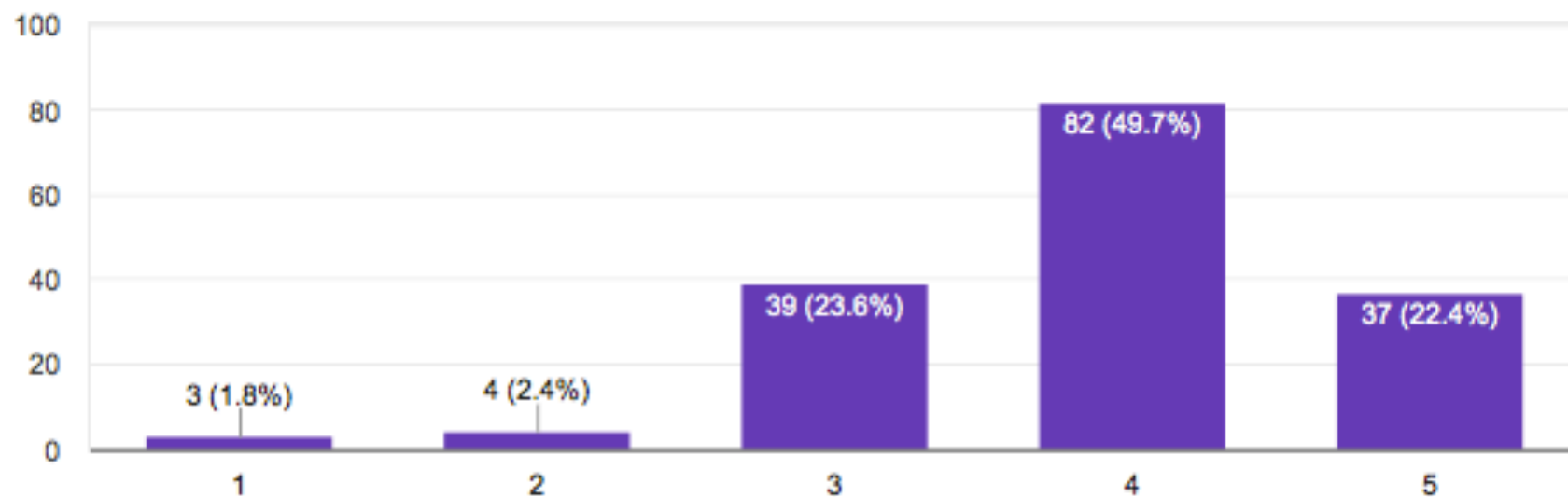

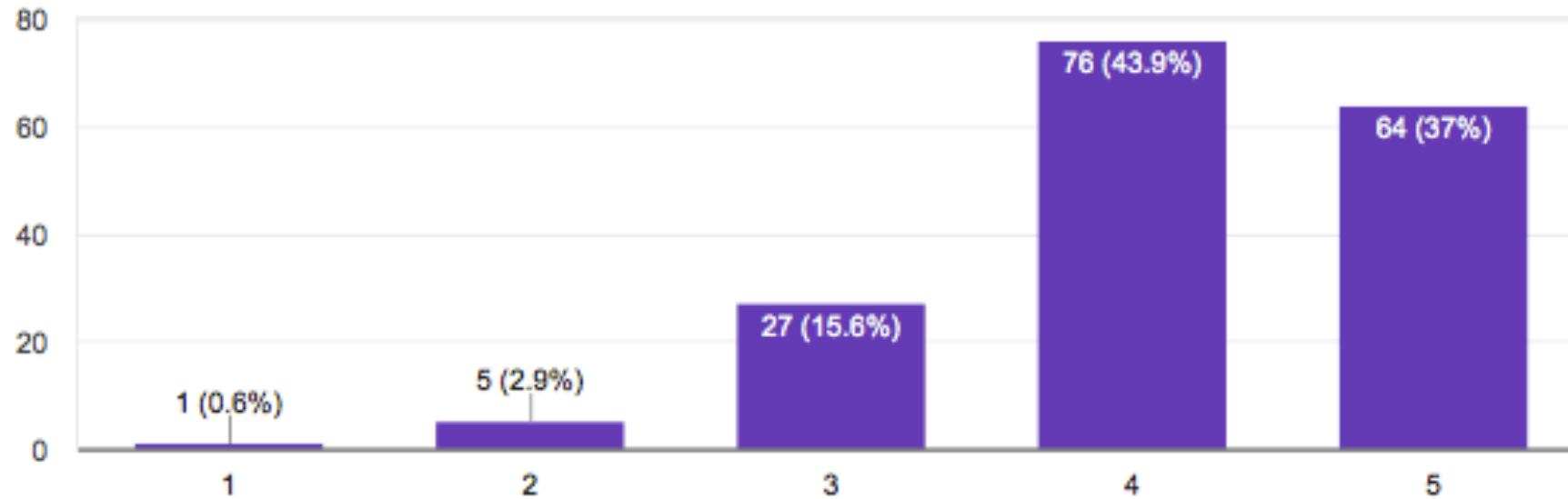

Overall how do you rate the club's effectiveness in letting you know what is going on?

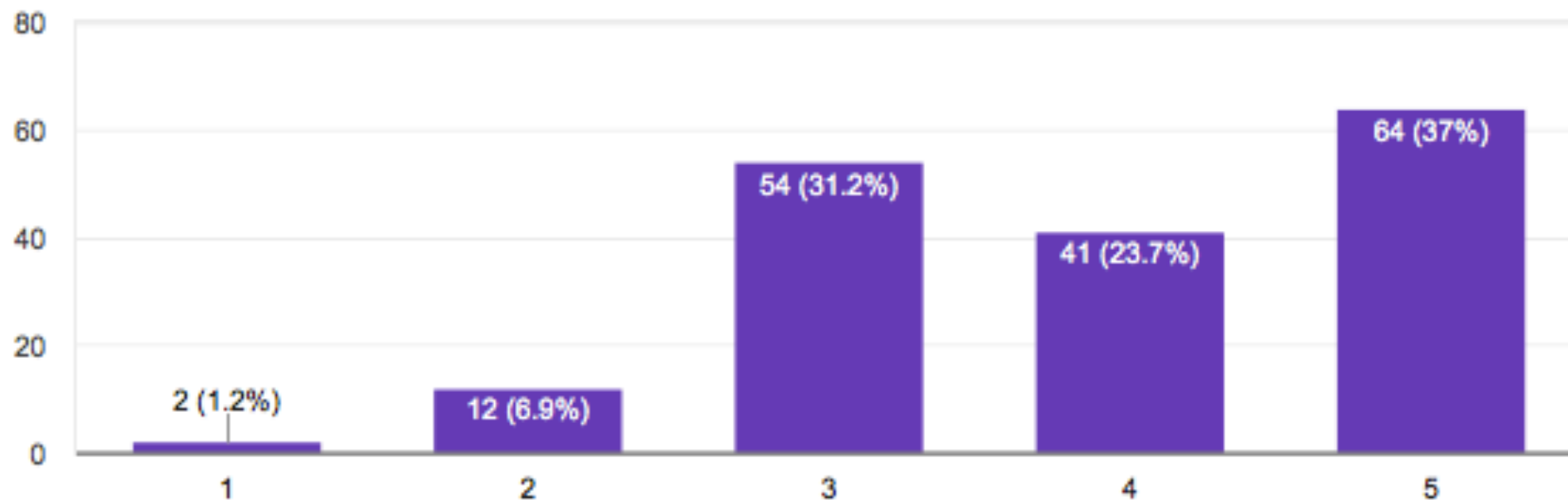

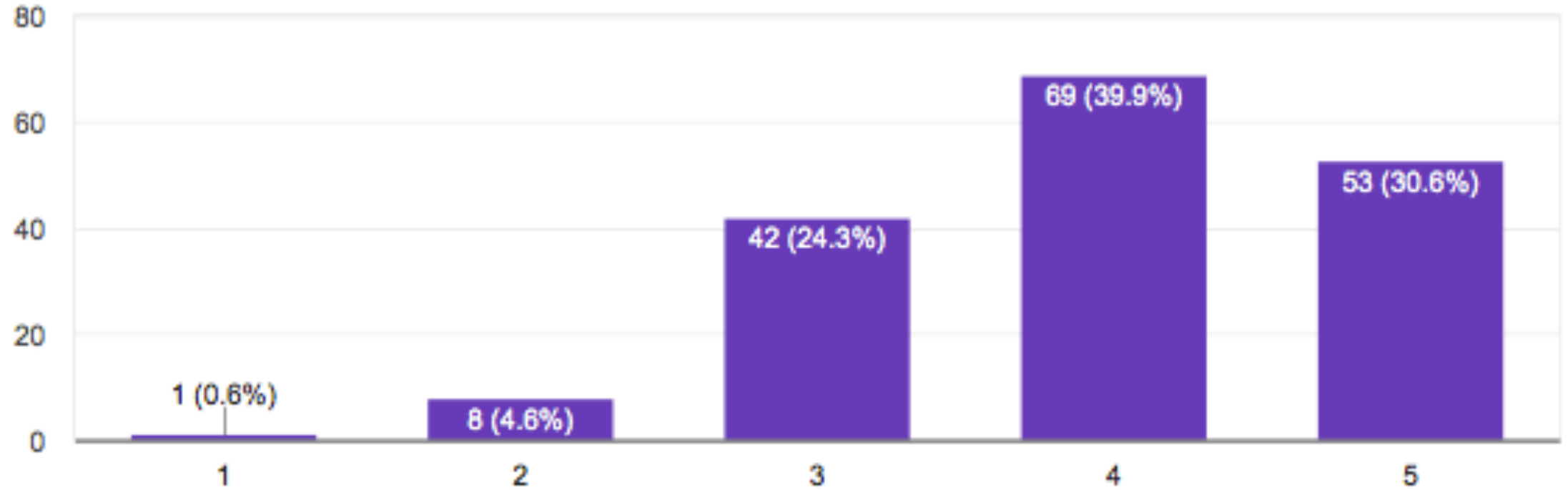

How do you feel overall about your membership of RTYC?



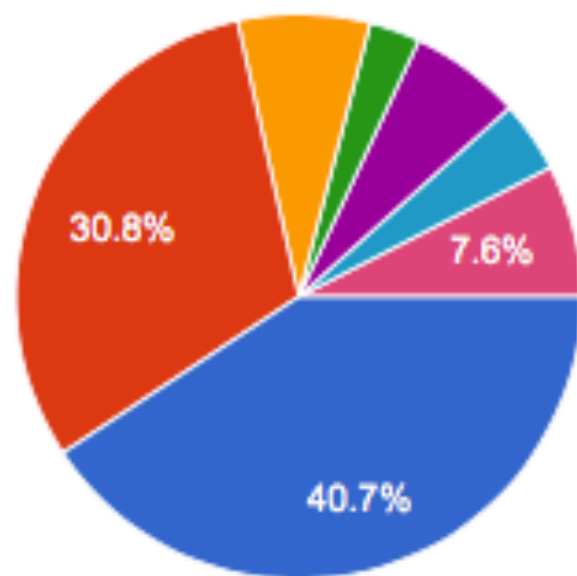

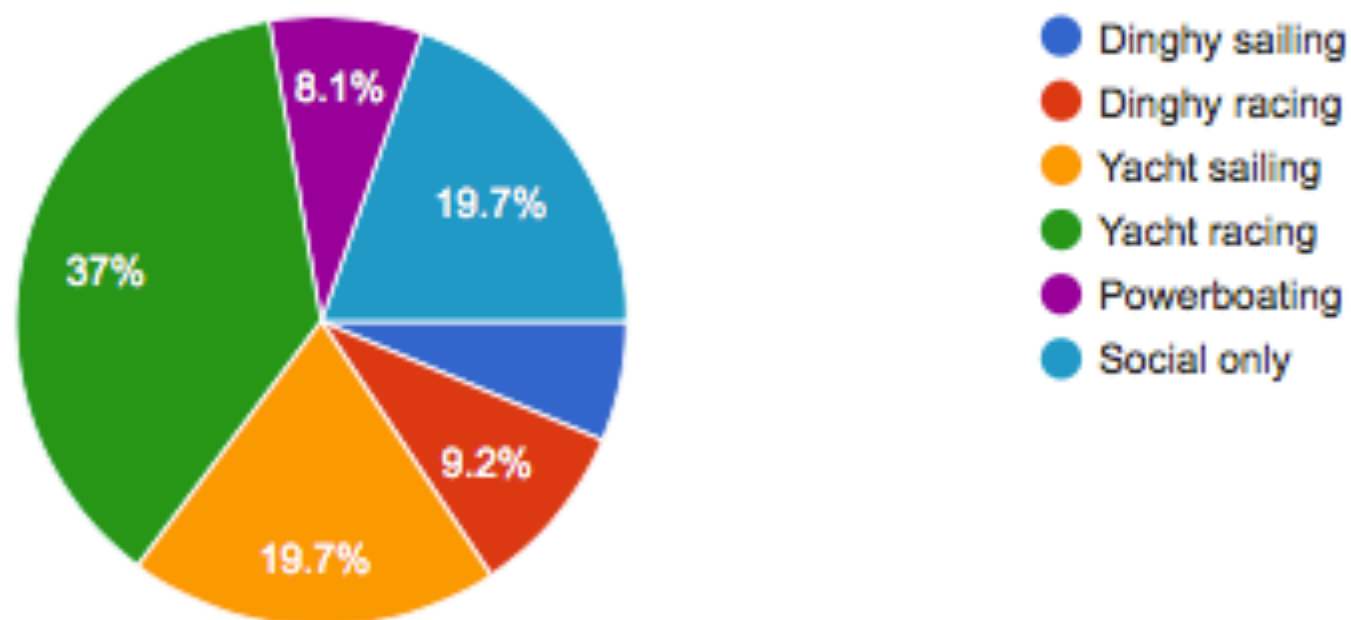

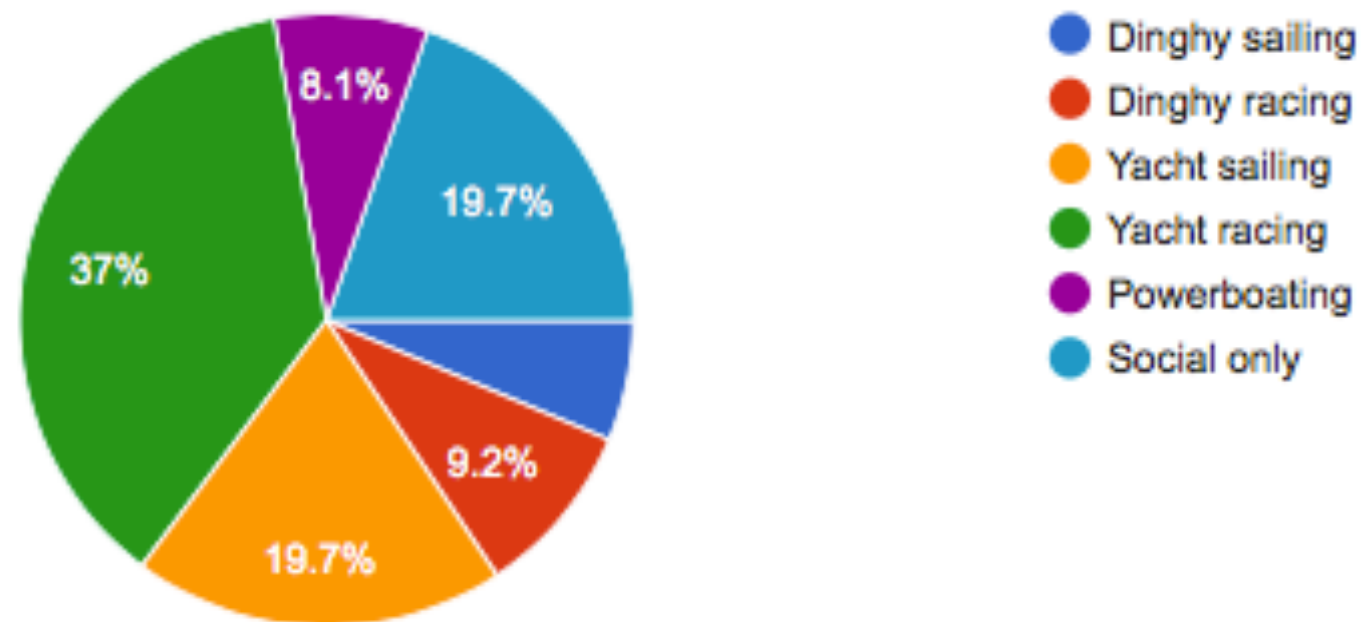

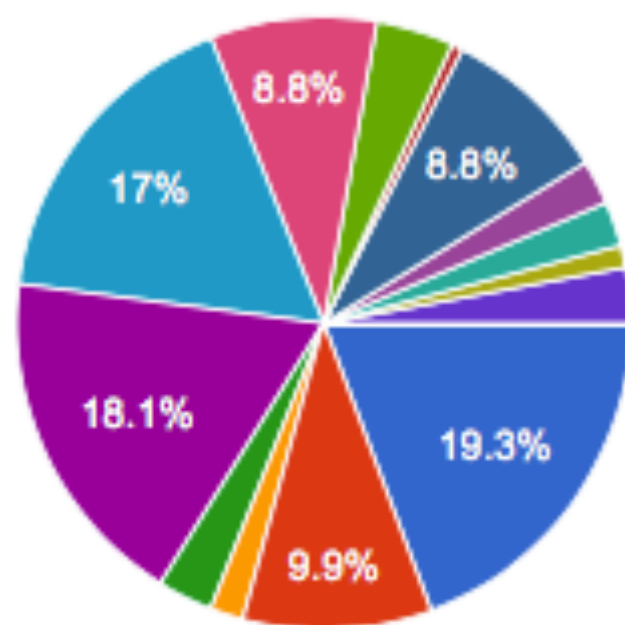
