## WELCOME and JOINING INSTRUCTIONS.

We are looking forward to welcoming you all to Torquay and to the Royal Torbay Yacht Club (RTYC) .

### PRIOR TO TRAVELLING

- Do think about booking tickets for sailing suppers and the BBQ's at the Royal Torbay Yacht Club.
- If you are coming to the Nationals book your inspection slot before you leave
- If you are only coming to the Europeans those booking slots will be open from Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> July.
- **Parental Declaration** - Complete this and bring with you for both the Helm and Crew
- Medical Information – if there is any medical information that you which make available to the organisers, please complete the Medical Information form, and bring it with you
- Both forms can be found on the event websites
- Ensure you bring your **Measurement certificate** with you
- Check out the website for latest information and any updates.

**The following notes and harbour plan will help you when arriving and during your time with us.**

### UPON ARRIVAL IN TORQUAY

- Follow the road signs to the Harbour and enter Beacon Quay (with the Harvester Pub on your left), at the barrier you will be welcomed by RTYC volunteers.
- Drive along Beacon Quay to the far end.
- RTYC volunteers will be on hand to direct and assist you with from 0900 until 1800 on Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> July, from 0830 until 1800 on Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> July, and from 0800 until 1200 on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> July.
- For access outside the hours please contact [events@rtyc.org](mailto:events@rtyc.org) or telephone 07970353660 in advance.
- Dinghy Parking will be on Haldon Pier
- Once you have dropped off your boat, your car should be parked in the nearby car park as there is strictly NO PARKING on the harbourside. The car park uses the Ringo payment app.

### **EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIPS**

- A further update will be sent to competitors who are only taking part in the European Championships and are expecting to arrive later.
- This update will include arrival and harbourside information
- Registration and Equipment Inspection times and dates can be found the Notice of Race.

### **CHECK IN ON THE HARBOURSIDE**

- All competitors are required to CHECK IN upon arrival with the Beachmaster on Haldon Pier.
- The Beachmaster will be based near the Flagpole and halyards close to the slipway.
- Dinghy parking spaces will be allocated at Check In.
- Coloured labels with Sail Number will be secured to your trolley for ease of identification when coming ashore.

### **SUPPORT BOATS AND SAFETY RIBS**

- Ribs may be launched from the slipway on Haldon Pier under the direction of the RTYC Beachmaster
- Trailers are to be parked at the end of Haldon Pier unless directed to park elsewhere.
- All ribs and support boats shall register at the Main Reception (RTYC)
- See also NoR 16 and SI 24

### **REGISTRATION**

- Registration will take place at Royal Torbay Yacht Club
- The times are in the Notice of Race and the Timetable, both can be found on the event websites.
- The Helm and Crew shall both attend. They are both required to bring with them their completed **Parental consent forms**, available from the event website.
- Any Medical Information forms should also be brought to registration.
- Registration is not complete until the Equipment Inspection process is also completed, see notes below and NoR 9 & 10

### **EQUIPMENT INSPECTION**

- Equipment Inspection will take place at the times set out in the Notice of Race
- Please make sure that you book your inspection slot on the event website at the earliest opportunity.
- Inspection of hull, spars and equipment will take place on the Harbourside next to the area marked Living Coast on the map included in this document.
- Sail measurement and inspection will take place in the Corinthian Room of the Royal Torbay Yacht Club,
- Both the helm and crew are required to attend.
- You will need to bring your **Measurement Certificate** with you to inspection
- You should complete the **Equipment Inspection form** as far as you are able to and bring it with you. This form will be published on the event website.
- You should report to the inspection area on the Harbourside at the required time with your boat, spars, and equipment
- Further inspection information will be published on the event website.



### CLUB ACCESS & INFORMATION

- At registration you will be given a club information pack which includes the Wi Fi code.
- An event Pin Number to enable access to the club using the main entrance or rear garden entrance will be included in the information pack.
- Please use the Pin Number for access as for security reasons the front door should be kept closed.

### BAR AND CATERING

- The **BAR** will be open throughout the event and we hope you will make good use of it.
- Adults may request a Temporary Membership card which will be available from the main reception at the club.
- This card can be used for access to the club and as a bar card entitling the user to 10% discount off bar prices (excluding special offers) The card is limited to these event only.
- Amounts of £10 or more may be placed on the card at the bar. We are unable to make refunds at the end of the event.
- **Food** will be available in both Corinthian Room and Restaurant throughout the events
- Sailing Supper Menus and bookings can be found on the event websites.
- BBQ tickets (July 29<sup>th</sup> and August 5<sup>th</sup>) are also to be purchased online.
- All tickets once purchased online are to be collected from the club main reception.
- Booking is always advisable, if you have not booked and space is available, you will be very welcome

## CHANGING ROOMS

- Male Changing Rooms, Showers and Toilets are located on the ground floor
- Female Changing Rooms, Showers and Toilets are located on the first floor, accessed from the stairs on the left of the entrance hall.
- Sailing bags and clothing should not be left in the changing rooms.
