3. [NP] COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

Delete 3.1 and replace with:

3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the competitors WhatsApp group.

10. THE COURSES

Delete 10.3 and replace with:

10.3 If a course is shortened such that the finish is at the leeward end of the course, then the finish line will be as defined in paragraph 15. This changes RRS 32.2.

11. MARKS

Delete 11.1 and 11.2, and replace with:

- 11.1 For courses identified in Appendix A, marks 1, 2p, and 2s will be Orange inflatables.
- 11.2 For courses identified in Appendix A, the change of course mark will be a Black inflatable.

14 CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE

Delete 14.1 and 14.2 and replace with:

- 14.1 To change the next leg of a course described in Appendix A, the RC will lay a new mark (or move the finishing line) and remove the original mark as soon as practicable. When, in a subsequent change, the new mark is replaced, it will be replaced by the original mark. If a new mark is laid, the change will be signaled.
- 14.2 Minor course changes (up to 150m) to a course described in Appendix A may not be signaled. This changes RRS 33.
- 14.3 To change the course for the IRC and Cruiser fleets, the RC will signal the change by displaying flag C and notify the new course to competitors on VHF Channel 72. This changes RRS 33.

17. TIME LIMITS AND TARGET TIMES

Delete 17.3 and 17.4 and replace with:

17.3 Boats in the IRC and Cruiser classes failing to finish within 30 mins of the first boat in their class will be scored Did Not Finish without a hearing. This changes RRS 61.4(b)(1).
